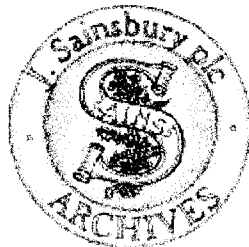


Victorian shop artefacts for the home corner display



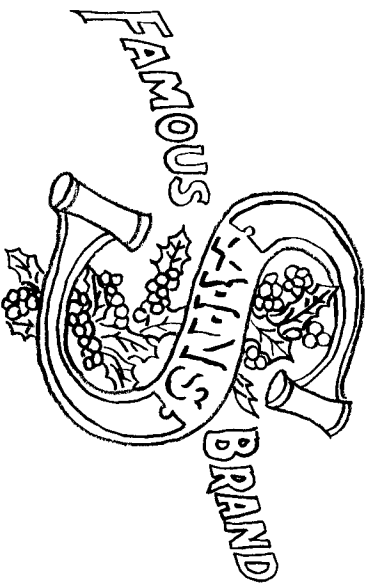

There are six things to do and make

- Tin of fruit -** Choose a label, pear or pineapple.
Colour in the label.
Cut it out and paste onto a clean tin.
- Tile 1 -** Finish the tile by drawing along the dotted lines. Colour in the tile. Look at the back of the shop if you want to see the colours that Sainsbury's used, but you can choose your own.
- Tile 2 -** The sheet with two tiles can also be coloured in. Ten of these tiles will go around the advertisement that is also in the pack.
- Tea packet -** Colour in the tea packet.
Cut out, fold and paste together to make an old fashioned tea packet. To save time you could photocopy the design onto coloured paper.
- Advertisement** Enlarge the advertisement on a photocopier to A3 and then use the long tiles described above (Tile 2) to go around it.
- Jam -** Choose a label, blackcurrant or apricot.
Write your name on the front of the label.
Colour in the label and the top.
Cut them out and paste onto a clean jam jar and lid.

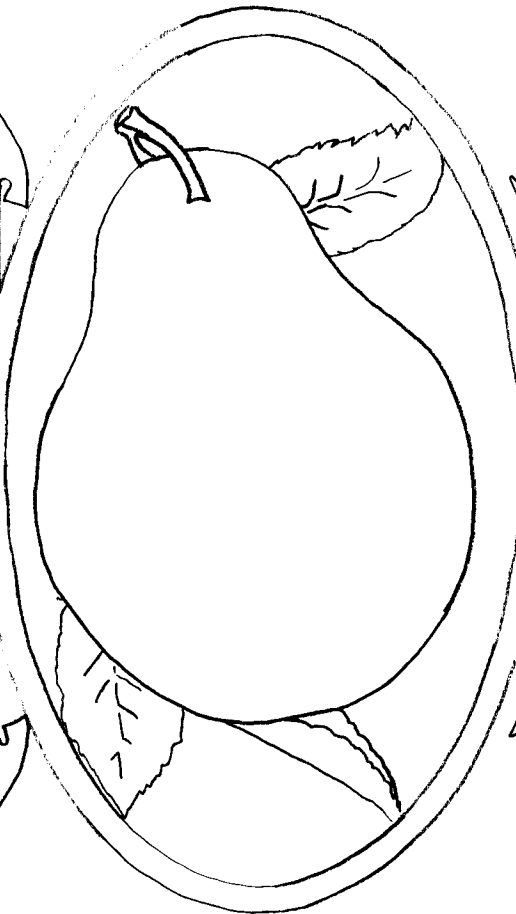
