
## How to interview Laurie Holmes about the air raid on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 1943

You are going to listen to part of an interview with Laurie Holmes. The interview is divided into five Real Player files to be found on the 1. Air Raid and 2. Rescue pages in the East Grinstead case study section of the Second World War site.

- 2 Click on 1. Air Raid to find the first file about what happened to Laurie when the bomb exploded OR

## 1. Air Raid

East Grinstead, like many other towns suffered damage from enemy action. The events of Friday 9 July 1943, resulted in one of the worst cases of civilian loss of life.

Late that afternoon, about ten Laurie Holmes describes the effects German aircraft crossed the Sussex coast at Hastings heading for (537Kb Realplayer file) 1 min 04 secs London. ## 2. Rescue

By the time the emergency services arrived many buildings including the cinema were burning furiously.

 ${f T}$ he Civil Defence and Heavy Rescue teams together with servicemen and civilians began to dig away at the rubble in the hope of finding survivors.

Laurie lay buried under the rear of the shop. Though heavily damaged.

The final casualties numbered 108 killed and 235 injured, among one
